

Things that students with a hearing loss should say to advocate for themselves

- *Can you please repeat that?*
- *Can you please speak louder?*
- *Can I move closer?*
- *The hallway is noisy. Can I shut the door?*
- *I can hear you all the time, except... (ex. during read aloud or when the fan is on)*
- *Will you turn the transmitter/microphone on please?*
- *My batteries died. Can I go to the nurse/to my locker to get more?*
